## Juniors and Senior

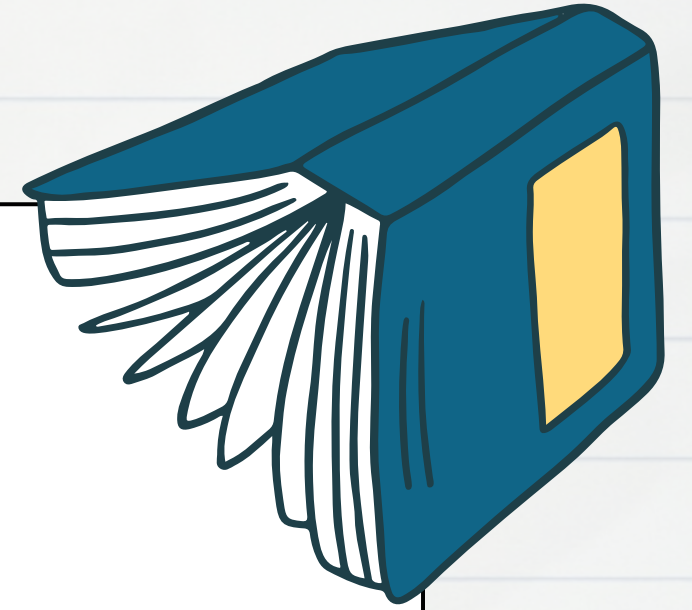

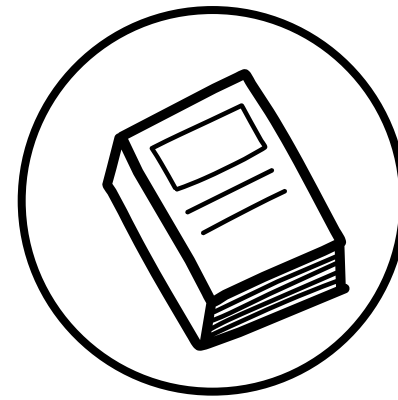
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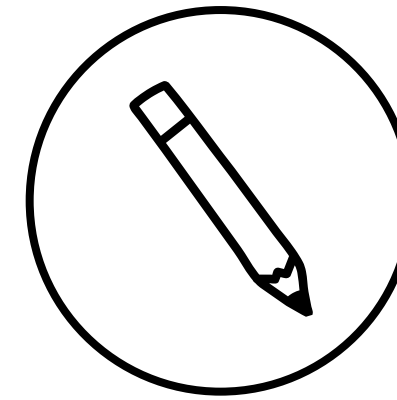
# What's in it for mentors?



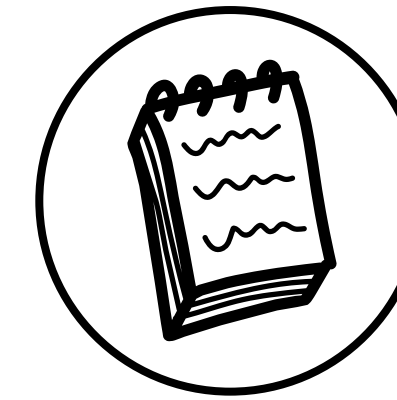
Mentor 3-4 first year students on academic, personal, and professional development topics.
